- 1. Read the essay question carefully.
- 2. Read the easy question once more.
- 3. Jot down in your own words what it means, preferably in one sentence.
- 4. Come up with two or three possible answers/opinions/arguments
- 5. Rewrite 3 and 4 as thesis and topic sentences.
- 6. Remember structure: thesis, topic and transition sentences
- 7. Find quotes or facts to substantiate your point of view.
- 8. Take some time to come up with an interesting opening and a title
- 9. Fill in the rest of the paragraphs.
- 10. Proof read to check for grammar, language and spelling mistakes.
